




### How to Make Coffee


Before first use: Wash coffee tank, filter basket, and drip tray in hot, soapy water. NEVER put the coffee tank in dishwasher. BrewStation® may have an automatic 2-hour shutoff. Press ON/OFF to shut off sooner.

#### **▲** WARNING Burn Hazard.

- Never use coffee tank to pour or carry hot coffee.
- Handle coffee tank only when holding cold water for fill and to clean tank after BrewStation® has been shut off
- If BrewStation® overflows, allow unit, coffee, and groucleaning unit, coffee, or grounds.







### Water Filter (optional accessory)

For better tasting coffee, use a water filter. Filter replacement is recommended every 60 cycles.









## Cleaning with Vinegar


Clean BrewStation® at least once a month (once a week for areas



Remove optional water filter.




Pour 1 pint (2 cups/500 ml) vinegar into water reservoir.




Press ON. **Turn OFF after 20 seconds and wait 30 minutes.**Press ON. Turn OFF when finished.

### Permanent Gold Tone Filter (Optional Accessory)

The Permanent Gold Tone Filter takes the place of disposable paper filters. Rinse in hot water before first use. Then simply place in the filter basket. Clean under hot, running water and let dry, or place on top rack of dishwasher.
